Meagher County COVID-19 (Coronavirus) Fact Sheet

To mitigate the threat of the COVID-19 (Coronavirus) to the Citizens of Meagher County, the following measures and services have been put into place:

With the exception of the Meagher County Library, all other City and County operations remain open for business.

The Steven's Youth Center is closed indefinitely

Mountainview Medical Center:

- No confirmed COVID-19 cases in Meagher County
- Two tests have been administered one test was negative one we are waiting on results
- Clinic is operating business as usual
- Telemedicine visits are now available, call the clinic to schedule an appointment
- All emergency and clinic visits will be accessed through the Clinic entrance
- Mountainview Medical Center has a "NO Visiting" restriction in place for ALL PATIENTS
- Hospital website will be used to filter current and updated information www.mvmc.org

- **Stay home if you are sick**
- **Avoid close contact with people who are sick**
- **Cover your cough, and avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth**
- **Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects**
- **Wash your hands frequently**
- **Social distancing is encouraged within stores and at checkouts, distancing of at least 6 feet between persons in the stores is recommended.**

If you are sick: You should wear a facemask when you are around other people (e.g., sharing a room or vehicle) and before you enter a healthcare provider's office. If you are not able to wear a facemask (for example, because it causes trouble breathing), then you should do your best to cover your coughs and sneezes, and people who are caring for you should wear a facemask if they enter your room.
